Incidental Music: Our hands between Sound and Image 2010-

Live audio manipulations from unauthorized popular culture sources produced alongside coloring pages created from similarly unauthorized imagery, then presented together to the listener to finish by coloring.

Are You My Mother: Imitation as Communication, 2009-

Imitating large ranges of objects traditionally considered incommunicative, these works use human sound and motion to complicate animate and inanimate meaning, remediation, and replication.

Instinct Control: Real-time Sonic Physicality, 2003-

Manipulations of physical space, obsolete technology, the body, and identity, Instinct Control has performed across the US in various venues from moldy stone basements to fine art galleries, artist residencies, and festivals, having released work in Japan, Germany, and the US.

Telling Lies: Creative (Non-)Fictions, 2002-

Experiments in myth-making invite the audience to become part of the work through the act of creative story-telling and lying expanded into representations and the assumed relationships therein.

Video Stills: Sequential Images Approximating the Instant, 2002-

Using various methods, these video works attempt to draw connection and distinction between temporal and atemporal representations, paying particular attention to notions of the continuous and discrete, emergent behavior, and human perception.
